Yvonne Ridley's Address in Auckland and Wellington

The Federation of Islamic Associations of New Zealand Inc. (FIANZ), the national umbrella organisation of the Muslim community, is pleased to announce that it will be inviting Ms Yvonne Ridley an experienced Journalist, who was once held as a hostage by the Taliban in Afghanistan in early 2000.

As a Journalist, Ms Ridley has extensively covered Afghanistan during the period when it was under the control of the Taliban. Soon after her release from Taliban, Ms Ridley embraced Islam. Since then, Ms Ridley has been travelling around the world speaking about the beauty of Islam. We had the pleasure of welcoming Ms Ridley to New Zealand in 2005.

FIANZ President Dr Anwar Ghani said, "while the Muslims in New Zealand generally enjoy greater freedom and lives in peace and harmony with others, Muslims living in other countries are not so lucky". He hopes that Ms Ridley's address will enlighten the wider New Zealand community on the plight of the Muslims especially in the light of the rising tide of Islamophobia, racism against Muslims and the so-called "War on Terror".
